**Thank you so much for buying my font !**

**Here is a quick tutorial on how to install it, so that you could access to the extra features such as ligatures and alternate glyphs.**

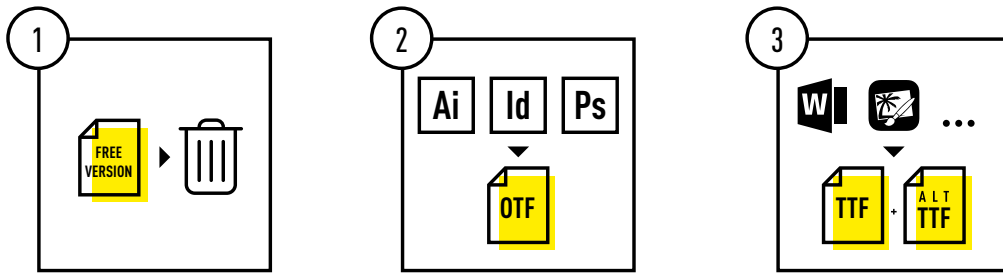
- 1 First, if you have installed a personal free version of the font on your system, uninstall and delete it, you don't need it anymore.
- 2 If you're working with Adobe Illustrator, Indesign, or Photoshop CC 2015, you'll just need to install the OTF file. Go to Text > Glyphs. In Photoshop CC2015 go to Type > Panels > Glyphs panel or Window > Glyphs. There you'll find the complete set for you to play with.

The OpenType features allows you to create alternates glyphs for a natural script effect.  
Just type a combination of letters to obtain a great result :

Ch > *Ch*  
ee > *ee*  
ff > *ff*  
fi > *fi*  
gg > *gg*  
it > *it*  
ll > *ll*  
mm > *mm*

nn > *nn*  
oo > *oo*  
pp > *pp*  
rr > *rr*  
ss > *ss*  
tt > *tt*  
th > *th*  
AT > *AT*

AND > *AND*  
WITH > *WITH*  
WHAT > *WHAT*  
IS > *is*  
OR > *OR*  
THE > *THE*  
TO > *TO*  
FOR > *FOR*  
BUT > *BUT*



- 3 If you're using any other program such as Microsoft Word, Publisher, Pages, Pixelmator, etc... you'll need to install both TTF files (font file + alternates file). Just write your text using « Beyond the Mountains », and pick up with «Beyond the Alternates» the alternate you want. To help, here is the glyph table :
