

How to install and use fonts in **CRICUT** **Design Space**

This guide will help you install and add fonts to Cricut Design Space. You may be used to using "SVG fonts" in design space, where you need to copy and paste or drag and drop each letter into your project. Design Space has had a lot of updates making it much easier for you to use your purchased fonts.

step one INSTALL THE FONTS

Before you can use the fonts in Design Space, you need to install them to your computer. Please do not try to upload the fonts directly to Cricut – this will cause you to get an “unsupported” format error.

WINDOWS

- Unzip folder that you downloaded.
- Go to the folder with the fonts and search for the .OTF or .TTF file (I recommend installing the OTF file if available).
- Double-click on the font as if you are opening an application.
- Click Install and wait till it's done.
- **That's It! You have now installed your font.**

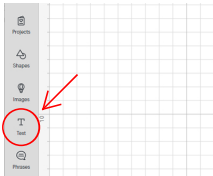
MAC

- Unzip folder that you downloaded.
- Go to the folder with the fonts and double click on either the OTF or TTF font file (I recommend the OTF file).
- After you double click a window will open with a preview of the font and a small button at the bottom saying “Install”.
- **Click install.**
- **That's It! Your font is now installed.**

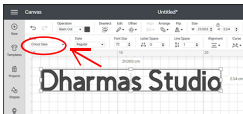
step two HOW TO USE IN DESIGN SPACE

Using your font in Cricut Design Space is very simple

First, open your project or start a new project
Click the "Text" button to start adding your text

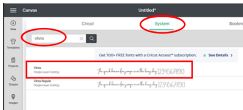


Type your word or phrase. Make sure the text is selected and click on the Font dropdown menu.



A menu will appear and you can choose the font that you want to use. Look for the name of the font in the menu.

For this example, I am using my font – Olivia. Click “System” then type “olivia” then enter, click the font that has appeared



Your text will automatically change to any font that you choose. After selecting Pink Daisy from the previous screenshot, our text is shown in a new design.
